WHO WILL BE THERE?

- **ADB-accredited U.S. firms** and their Asian affiliates will participate in private meetings with key officials during this special event. The U.S. Commercial Liaison Office for the ADB will help facilitate access to ADB Annual Meeting seminars for about 25 U.S. non-financial firms and will arrange appointments at the side U.S.- China event in advance for U.S. firms, especially about 25 U.S. non-financial firms and their Asian affiliates.
- **About 25 key Chinese central and local government officials** responsible for planning, implementing, regulating or financing public and private infrastructure projects in the agriculture, education, energy, environment (including water/wastewater treatment), financial services, public administration, telecommunications and transportation sectors. ADB plans **\$4.2 billion** in loans and technical assistance to China's public sector in 2002-2004. Additional ADB resources are available for private infrastructure projects.
- **Officials and businesses from Western China** are expected: Chongqing, Gansu, Guangxi, Guizhou, Inner Mongolia, Ningxia, Qinghai, Sha'anxi, Sichuan, Xinjiang and Yunnan. **Other ADB-assisted parts of China** may also be represented: Anhui, Fujian, Hainan, Hebei, Henan, Heilongjiang, Hubei, Hunan, Jiangsu, Jilin, Liaoning, Shanxi, Shandong, Tianjin and Zhejiang.

WHY SHOULD YOUR FIRM BE THERE?

- **For pre-arranged appointments** with key Chinese officials about developing new public or private infrastructure projects and about ADB and U.S. Government assistance. Chinese interpreters are available for hire by advance reservation or on site.
- **To position your firm for the procurements** which will follow the development of new public and private Chinese infrastructure projects supported financially by ADB.
- **To network** with leading international business, financial, ADB and government participants in the seminars of the main ADB Annual Meeting and in the seminars and social events of the side U.S.- China event. Free scheduled shuttle service will be provided between the main event and the nearby side event.
